It is with great pleasure that I report that we recently held the Inauguration of the *Joseph and Racheline Barda Chair for the Study and Research of Jewish Heritage in Egypt*. The event was extremely moving and it was truly a memorable occasion enjoyed by all.

The Inauguration took place on October 14th, 2013 in the presence of the President of the University Mr. Amos Shapira, the Dean of the Faculty of Humanities, Prof. Reuven Snir, the incumbent of the Chair, Prof. Tamar Zewi and our distinguished guests, Mr. Joseph Barda and his lovely wife Dr. Racheline Barda.

The ceremony included a documentary about a model of the Alexandria *Elyahu Ha Nabi* Synagogue that has recently been constructed and is displayed at Beth Hatfutsot Museum as well as a wonderful performance from Wasim Kahsebon, a student at our Department of Music who played the Oud and sang beautiful Egyptian music of years gone by to the delight of the audience.

During the ceremony, we heard a lecture from Prof. Uri M. Kupferschmidt from our Department of History of the Middle East who spoke about Memory and History. We also heard from Mrs. Levana Zamir, President of the Israel Association of Jews from Egypt and Dr. Racheline Barda who spoke to us about The Heritage of the Jews of Egypt.

At the conclusion of a very moving speech Mr. Joe Barda announced a new initiative: the establishment of a yearly grant to a graduate student who researches Jewish Heritage in Egypt and publishes on the issue. He concluded with his hope that more people donate funds for the purpose of this type of research.
